2017 Benz E300L




**Function Description:**

For Benz E300L model equipped with electronic parking brake, it is required to use this function to release and reset the electronic parking brake when replacing or repairing the rear wheel brake.


# LAUNCH

## Steps:

1. Select "Reset".




2. Select "Brake Reset".



# LAUNCH

3. Select "Mercedes-Benz" after entering




4. Select "Automatic Scan", follow the prompt "Turn on ignition", and then click "OK" to enter.




# LAUNCH

5. Select "Move To The Assembly" and click enter.




6. Click the "F3: Move To The Assembly" menu to release the brake sub-pump, and the interface prompt "Brake Is Released" at the same time




# LAUNCH

7. Now the rear brake caliper are in assembly position, you can replace the brake pad now



8. After the brake pad replacement job done, click the menu "F4 Deactivate Assembly Position" to retract the brake sub-pump, and the interface prompts "Is Actuated".

9. After successful retraction prompt "open", click "exit" menu to end the program
