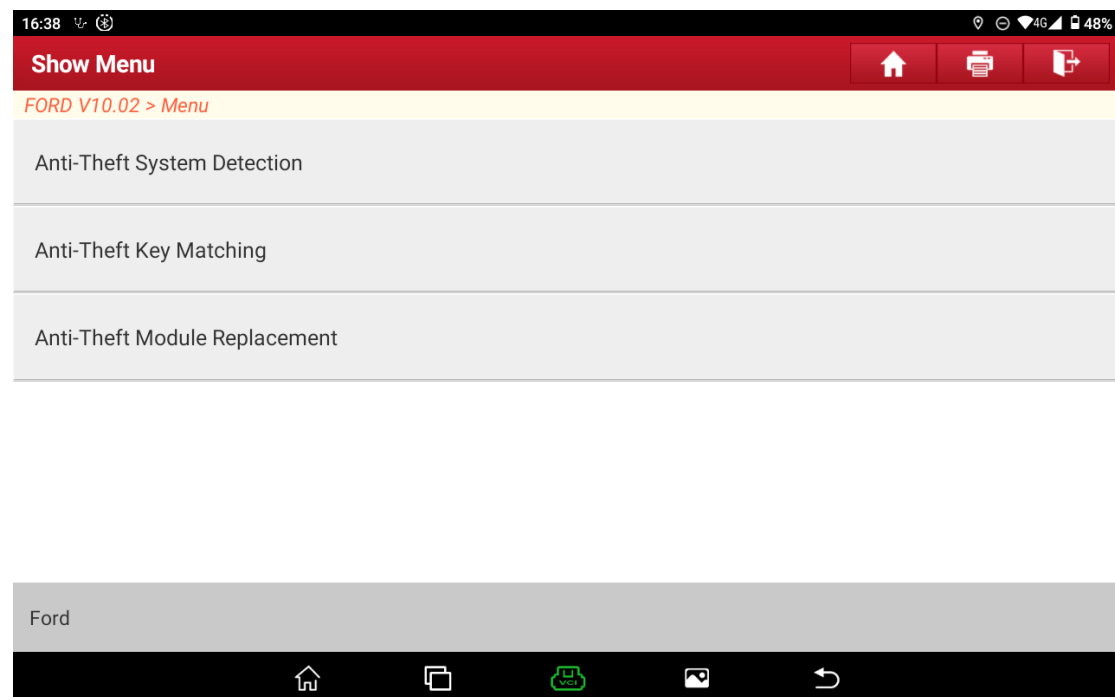
After engine module replacement or firmware upgrade, it is necessary to perform anti-theft matching.

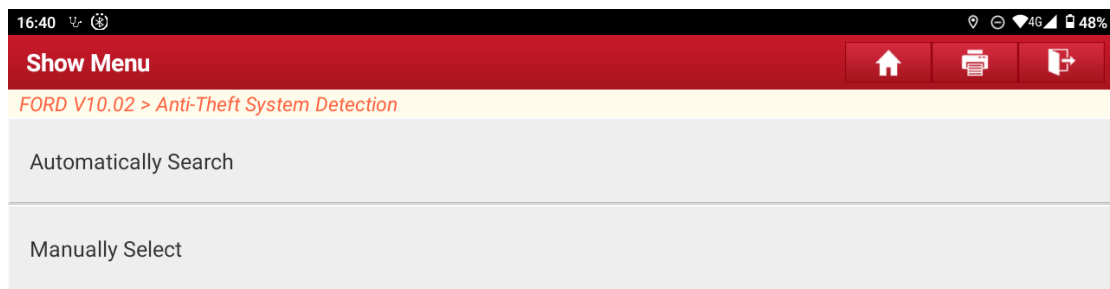

Procedure:

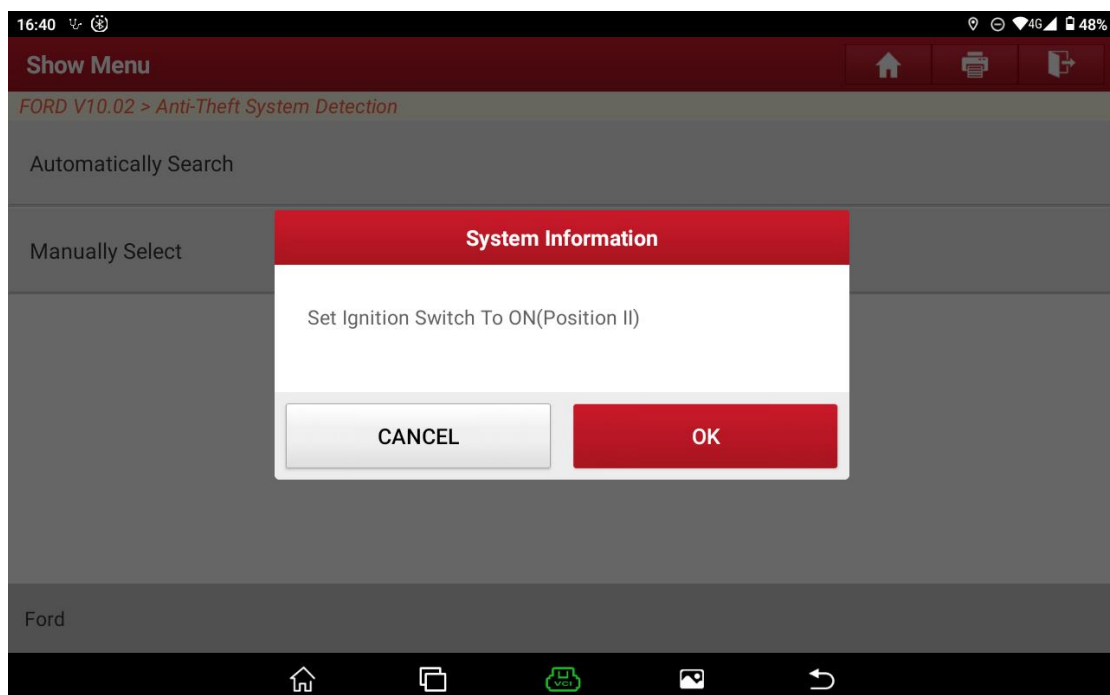
1. On an IMMO Pro, enter the Ford IMMO menu and choose [Anti-Theft System Detection].



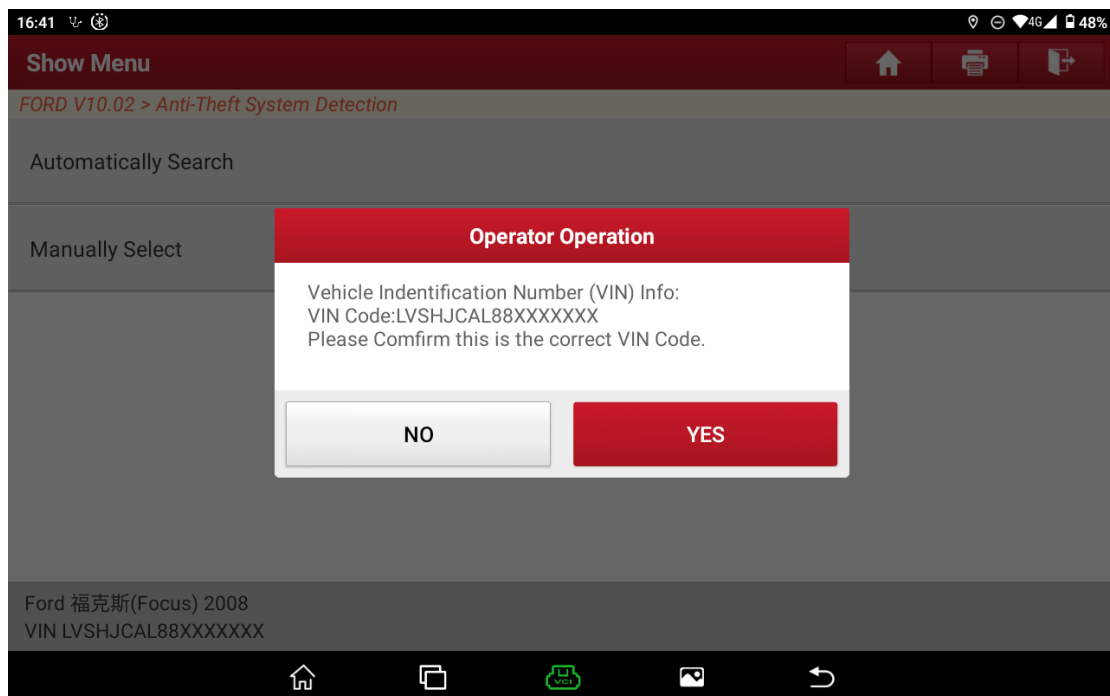
2. Choose [Automatically Search].



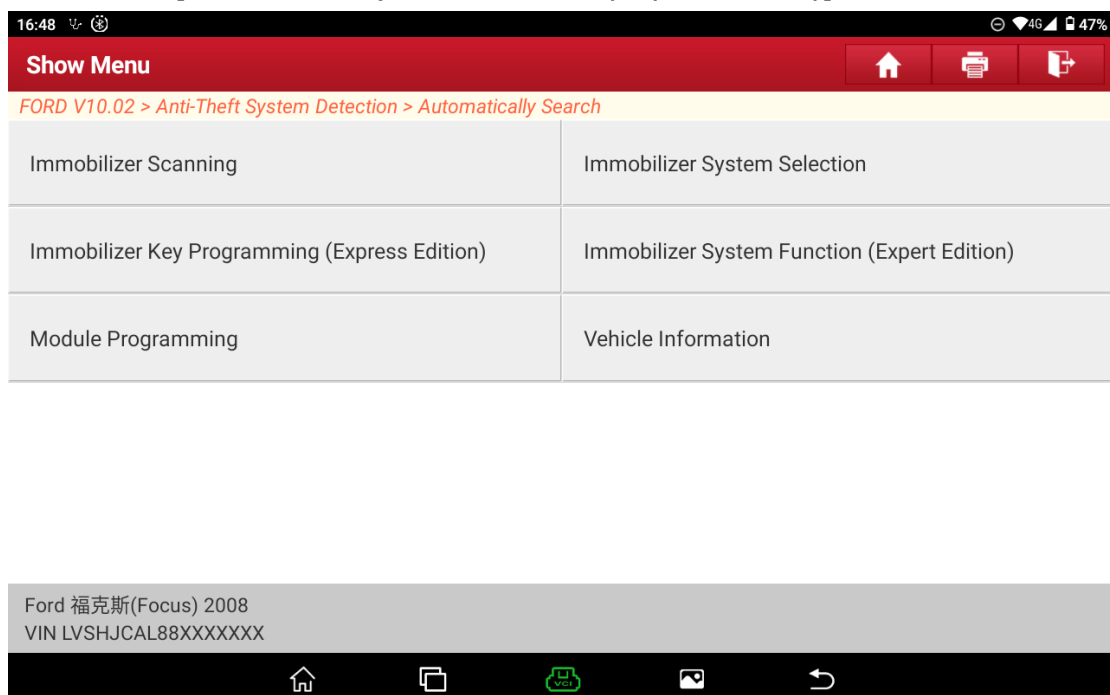
3. Choose "OK".



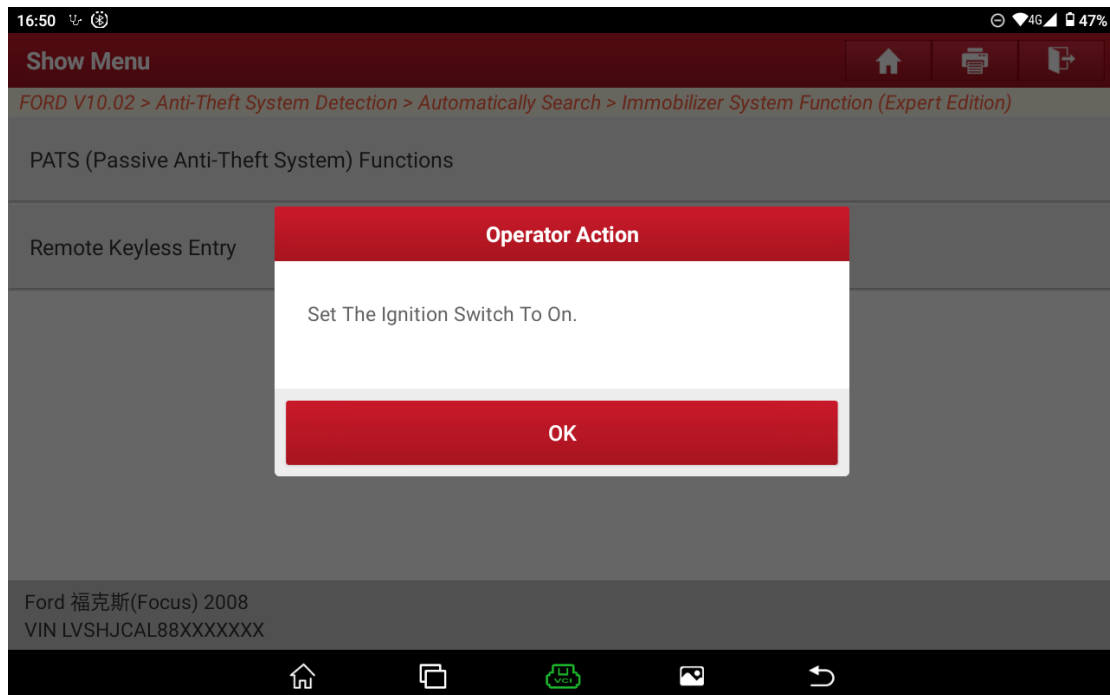
4. Choose "YES".



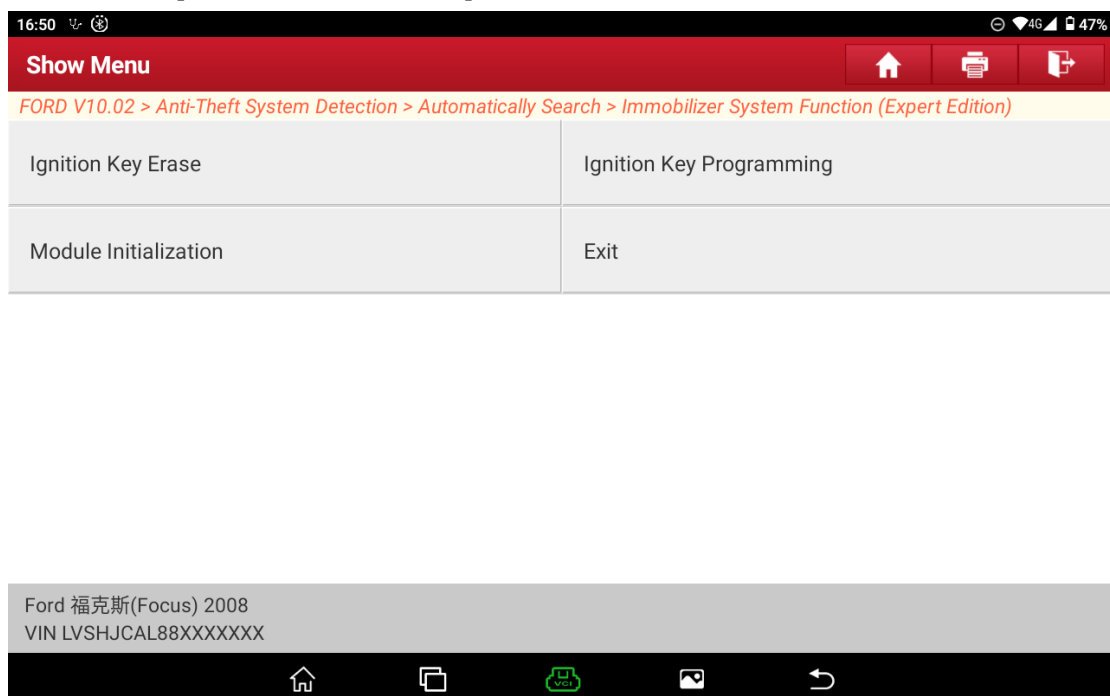
5. Choose [Immobilizer System Function (Expert Edition)].



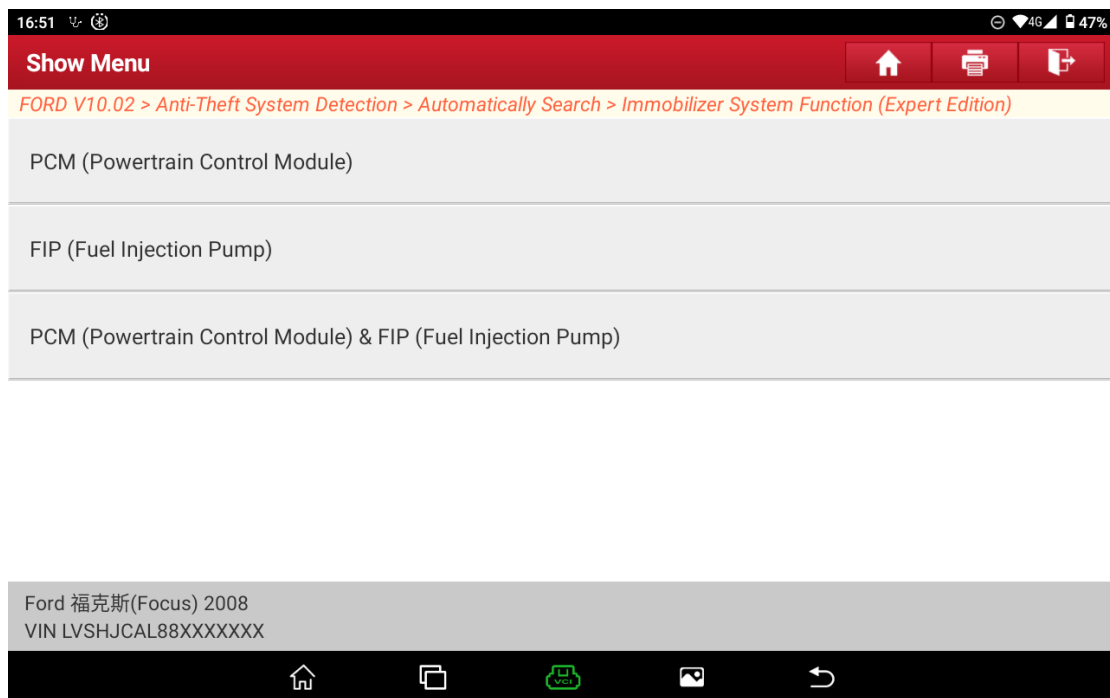
6. Turn on the ignition switch, and then click "OK".



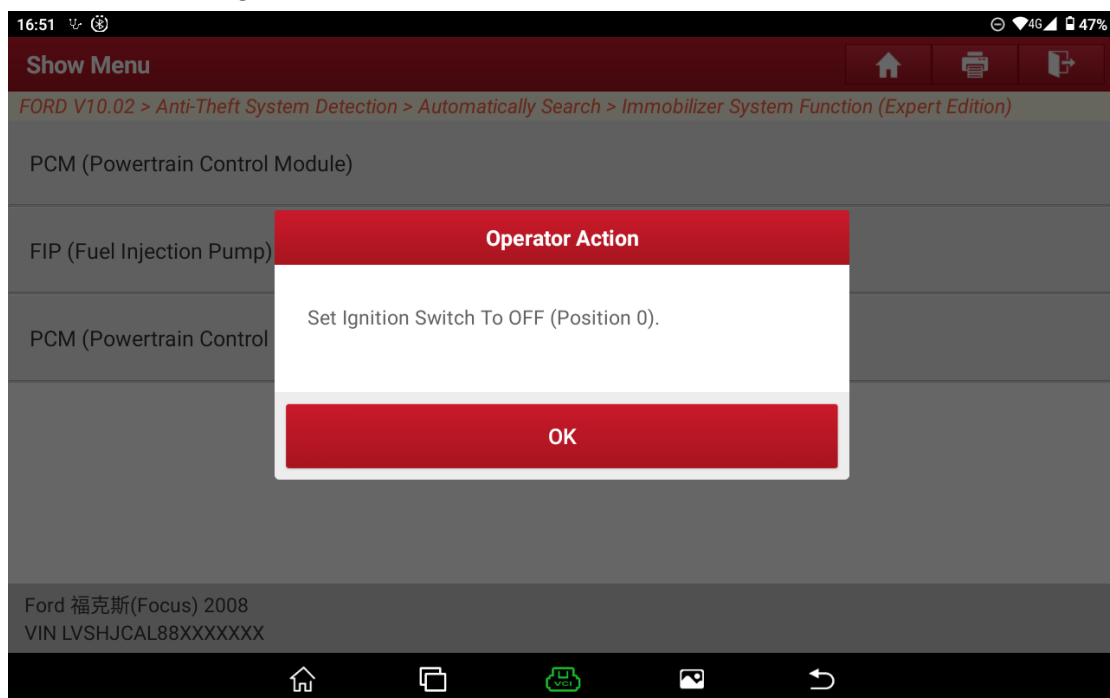
7. Choose [Module Initialization].



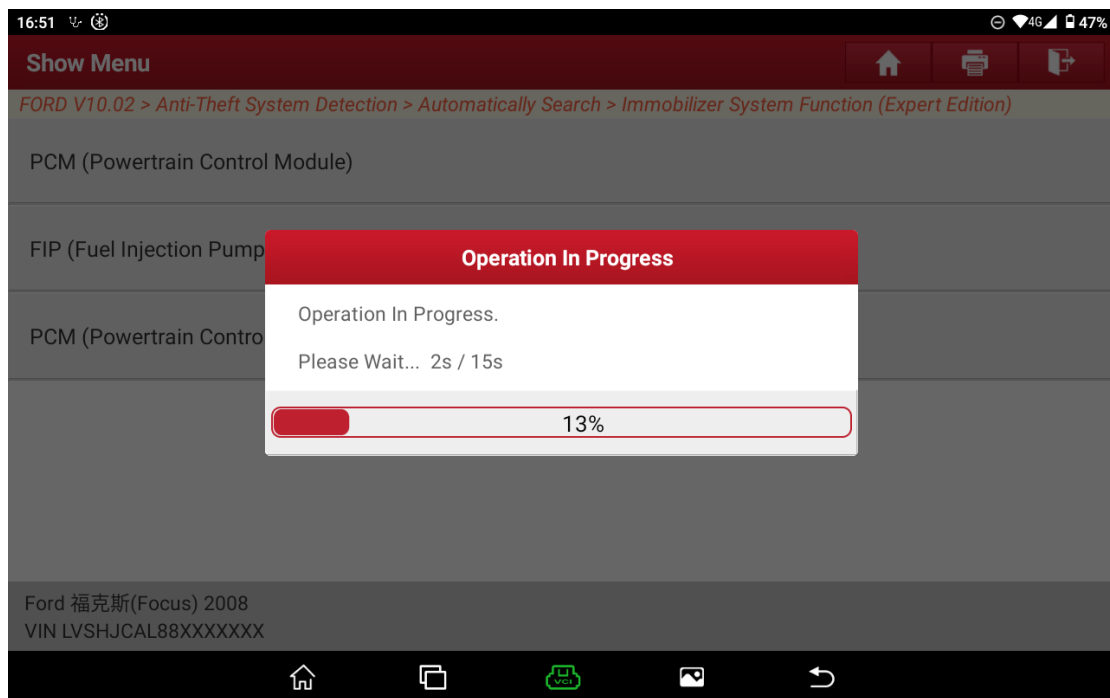
8. Choose [PCM (Powertrain Control Module)].



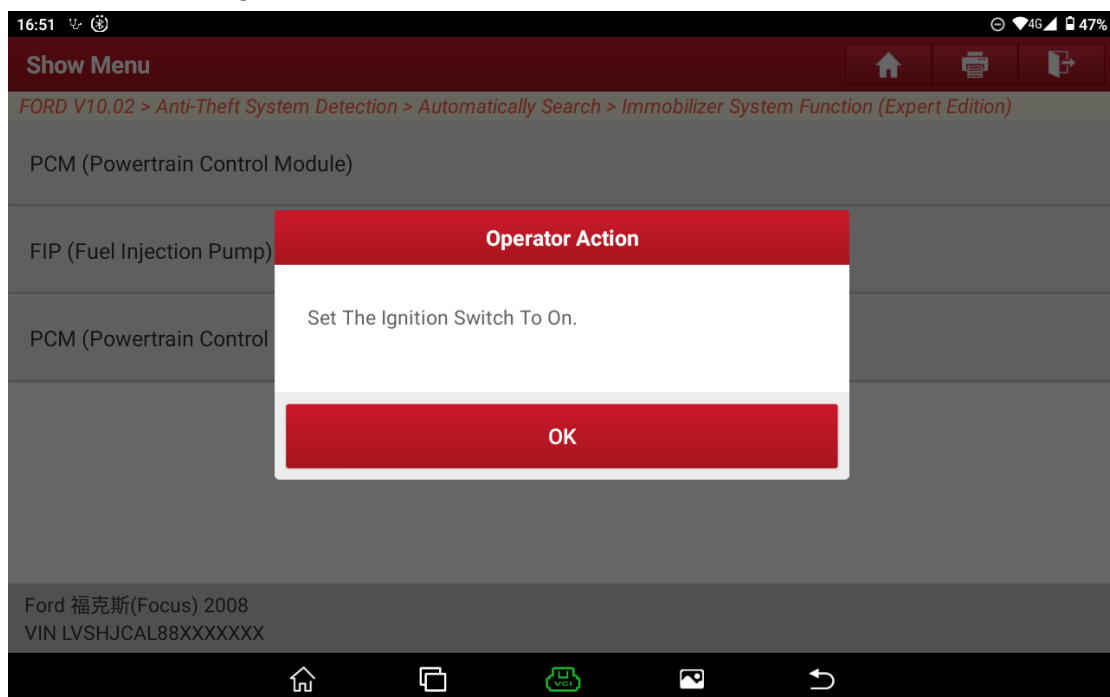
9. Turn off the ignition switch, and then click "OK".



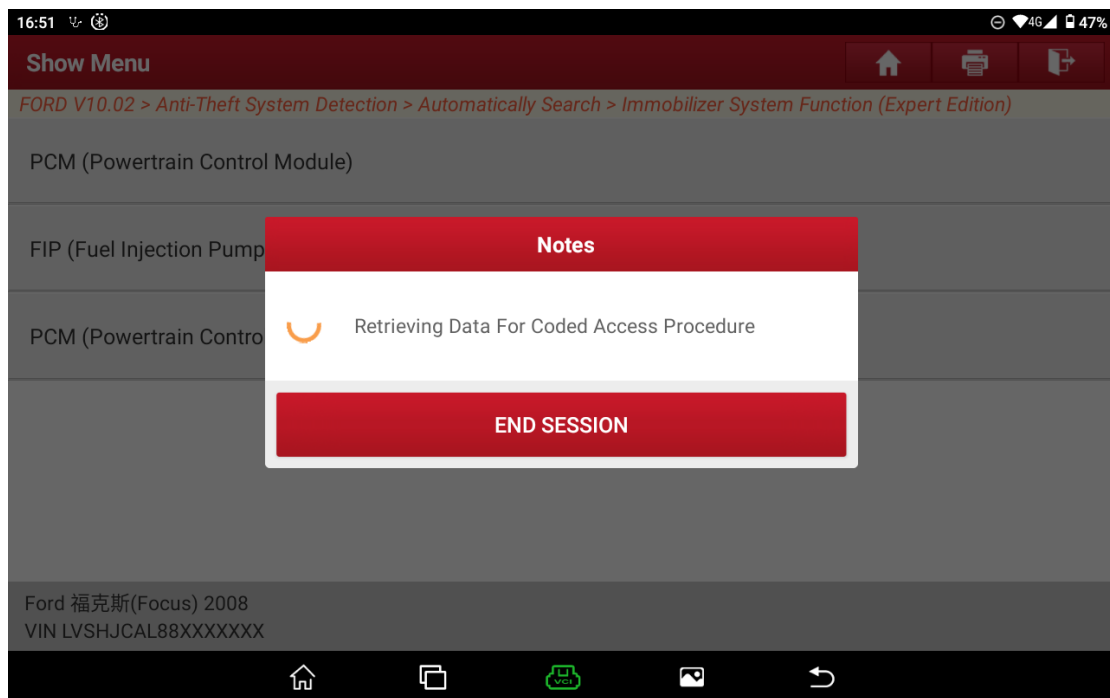
10. Operation in progress.



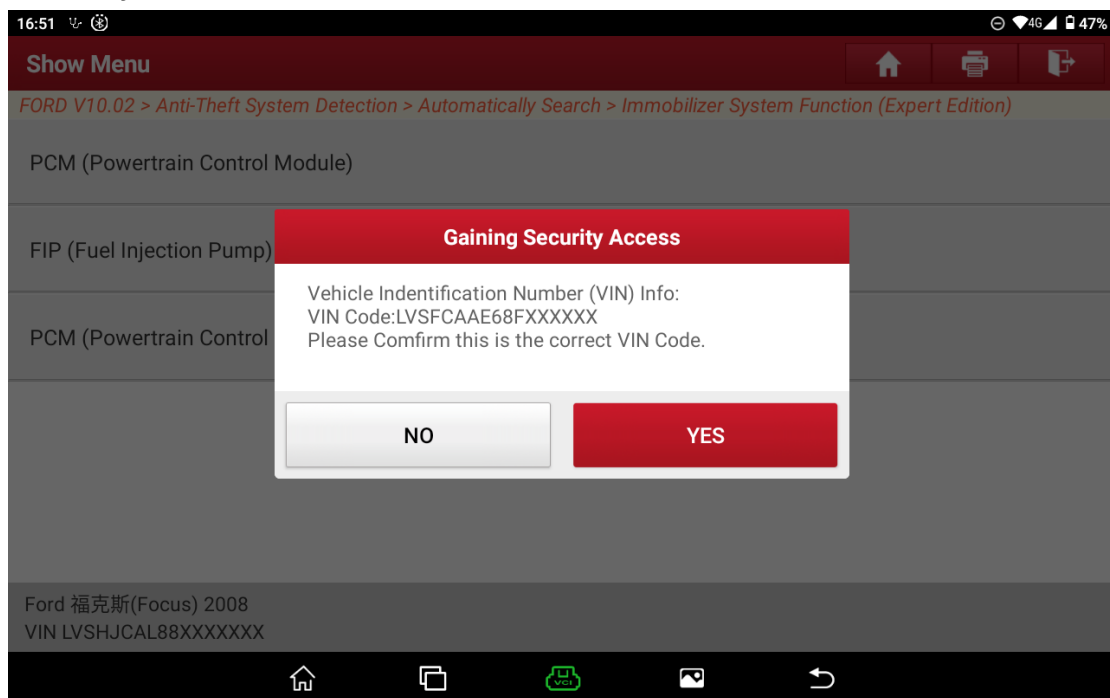
11. Turn on the ignition switch, and then click "OK".



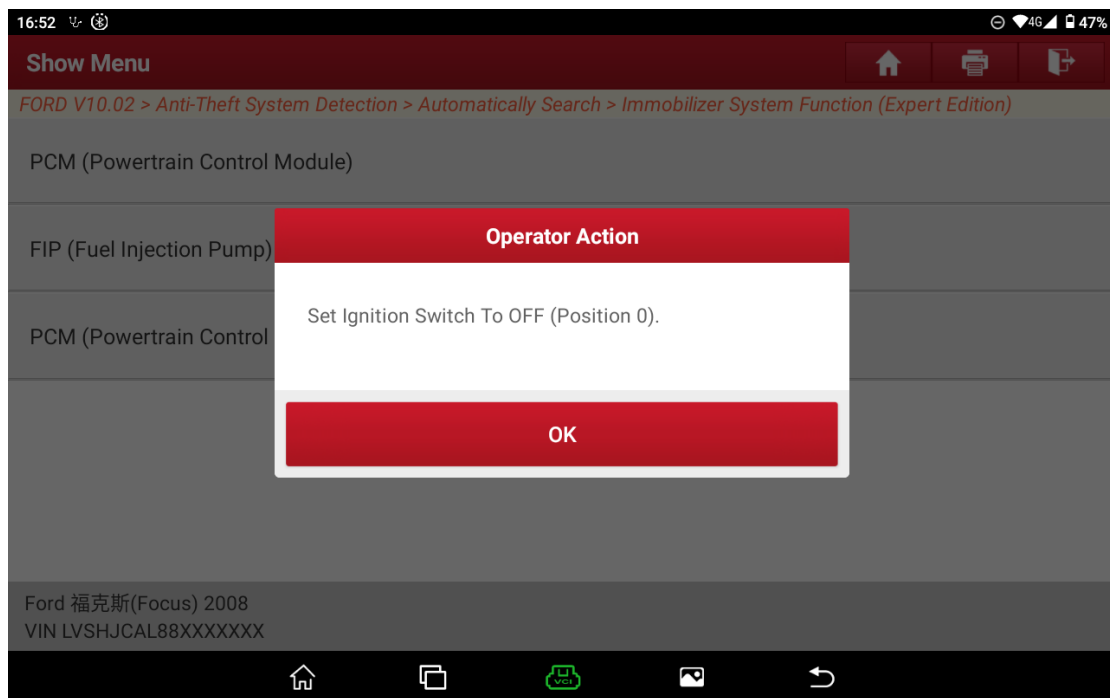
12. The prompt "Retrieving Data For Coded Access Procedure" is displayed.



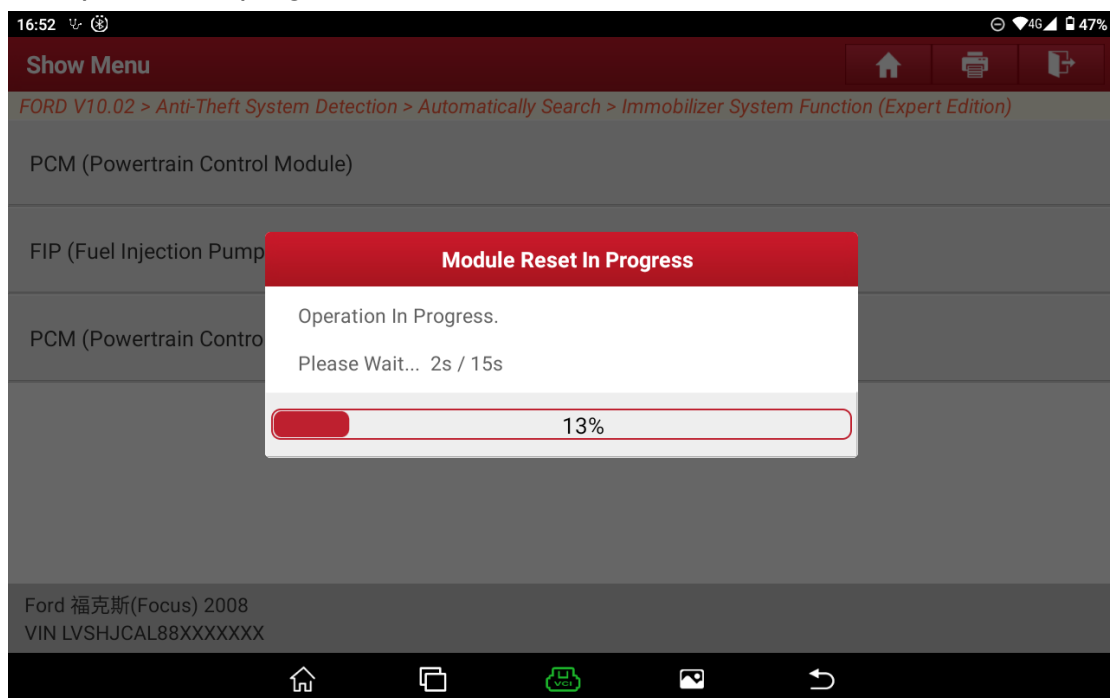
13. Verify the vehicle VIN, and then click "YES".



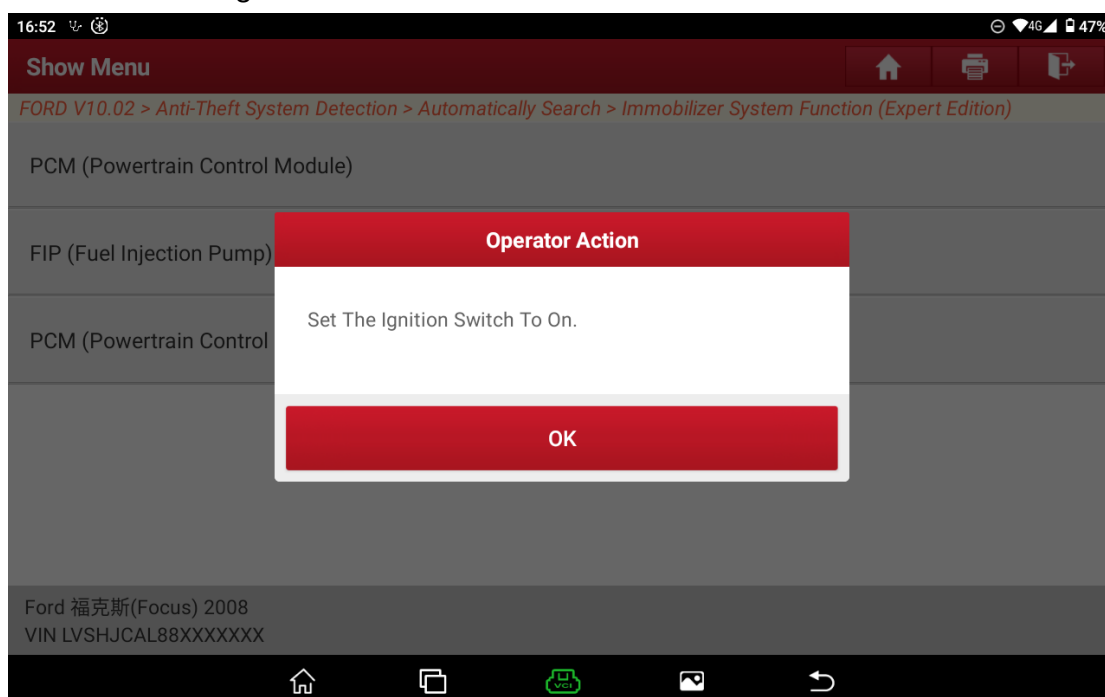
14. Turn off the ignition switch, and then click "OK".



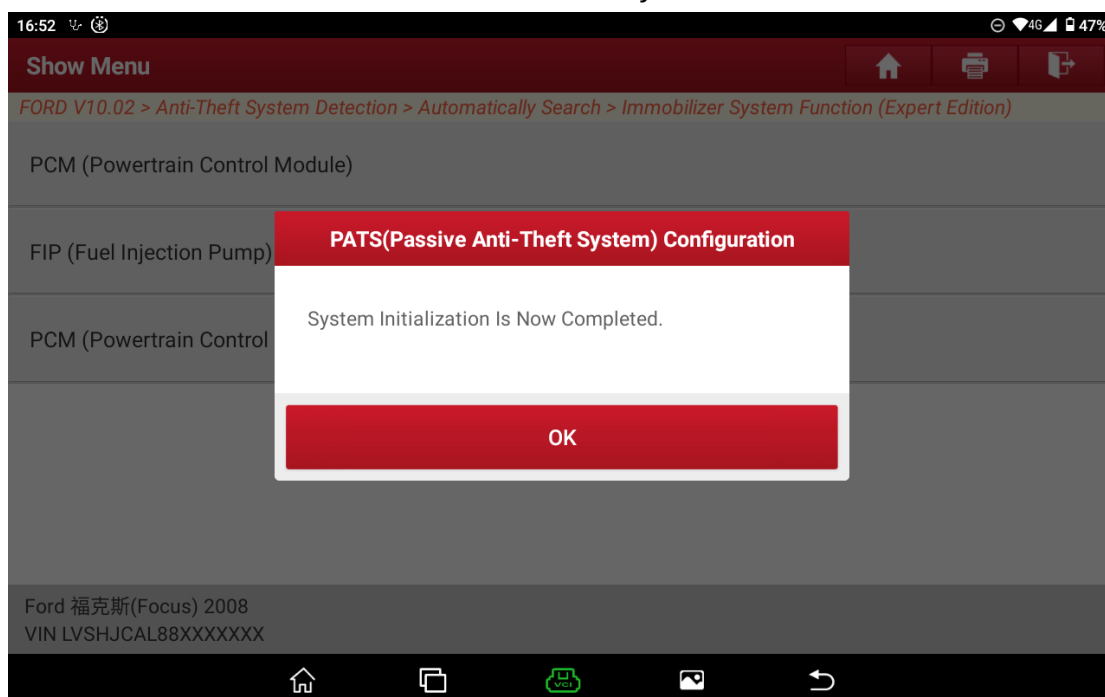
15. Operation in progress. Wait for 15 seconds.
