- Ignition ON and engine stopped.
- Parking brake switch pressed and instrument panel brake lamp off before basic setting

Procedure:

- 1) Turn on the ignition switch.
- 2) Choose brake pad reset V10.40 or a later version.
- 3) Choose AUDI. See Figure 2.



6) Note the brake pad replacement conditions. See Figure 5.













15) Click OK to replace the brake pads. See Figure 14. When replacing the brake pads, if the motor







19) Wait for about 30s. The brake calipers have been closed. See Figure 18.



20) Click OK. Brake pad replacement is completed. See Figure 19.


