



5. The normalization status of the tailgate is "Not normalized". Click "Continue". (See the following figure.)



6. The status of the rotary tumbler is "Closed". Manually open the trunk lid. (See the following figure.)



7. The status of the rotary tumbler is "Open". Click "Continue". (See the following figure.)






